# DID YOU KNOW?

Blight is a common and devastating disease in the vegetable garden, caused by a fungus (*Phytophthora infestans*). It spreads in particular during summers with heavy rainfall and temperatures between 10 and 25°C.

# WHAT ARE THE SOLUTIONS?\*

Some treatments are available, but the risk of attack can be reduced by using resistant varieties and adopting several measures:


- Use healthy seeds or plants.
- Avoid proximity to a potato crop, as well as petunias and flowering tobacco, which are potential hosts of *Phytophthora infestans*.
- Aerate your greenhouse crops as much as possible to avoid high humidity rates.
- Water the base of your plants rather than the foliage.
- Eliminate affected leaves as you spot them and take them out of the garden to avoid contaminating healthy plants.

With a very humid summer, this year these 8 varieties have been put to the test and proved to be an additional asset to meet the needs of gardeners! Among them, our two champions PAOLINE\* and HONEY MOON definitely proved their worth!
