Semis direct en pleine terre (température minimale du sol en surface 14-16°C), en terrine avec repiquage ou directement ou mottes ou godets sur substrat humide mais pas détrempé. Température de germination 23-25°C (2-3 jours). Repiquage au stade cotylédons étalés. Elevage nuit mini 14-15°C, jour mini 16-20 °C. Aérer progressivement la pépinière pour veiller à ne pas laisser filer les plants et les durcir avant plantation (fin de l'élevage en extérieur par exemple). Durée d'élevage du plant : 10-15 jours selon la période et dimension de la motte. L'utilisation de plant apporte plus de précocité.
